The Personnel Committee of the Piatt County Board met on Tuesday, October 29, 2024 in Room 104 of the Courthouse. The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. by Chairman Todd Henricks. Henricks, Jerry Edwards, Michael Beem, Gail Jones, Dustin Harmon, and Justin Greeley attended. Kathleen Piatt and Paul Foran were absent.

<u>Motion</u>: Edwards made motion, seconded by Jones to approve the minutes of the August 23, 2023 meeting. On voice vote, all in favor and the motion carried.

The committee discussed oversight for hiring for the coroner's office. Troy Dunn, the coroner, explained that he is having trouble hiring. He is working in Danville, and when there is a call, there is sometimes a long wait. He is also unable to go out of town because he lacks staff to cover for him. He proposes hiring a chief deputy coroner at \$3500 per year, who could cover while he is out of town. He would also like to hire his son, who is a student locally, and would be able to cover calls Monday through Friday. The handbook states a supervisor cannot supervise a family member.

An ad will be placed for Chief Deputy Coroner on Indeed, the website and in the newspaper.

<u>Motion</u>: Beem made a motion seconded by Jones that the hiring for the coroner's office should be done through the personnel committee moving forward. Roll was called, all in favor and the motion carried.

Motion: Beem made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Jones. On voice vote, all in favor and the motion carried.
