Building and Grounds Minutes

December 4, 2024

The Building and Grounds Committee of the Piatt County Board met Wednesday, December 4, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 104 of the Piatt County Courthouse. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.by Jerry Edwards. Attending: Paul Foran, Todd Henricks. Also attending were William Chambers, Doug Winder, Jennifer Harper, Tony Kirkman, and Keri Nusbaum.

Minutes of the November 6, 2024 meeting were presented.

<u>Motion</u>: Foran made a motion, seconded by Henricks, to approve the minutes of the November 6, 2024 meeting as amended. On voice vote, all in favor.

Public Safety Building

Winder reported that a boiler stopped working Thanksgiving morning, and again around 2 am the next morning. After a call to a technician, it was repaired Friday morning. There are additional parts on order. They also got the lobby heater running and did plumbing repairs and maintenance.

Piatt County Office Building

Winder is having some studies done to determine the power required for a new generator which will determine the size of a new storage tank. He is getting some costs for a battery backup for the elevator versus generator power backup.

Courthouse

It was determined that the window in the fire damaged probation office will need to be replaced. Bacon and VanBuskirk are working to find a suitable replacement. The existing window is from 1985 and cannot be matched. The installation for the Voltus demand response energy project has begun.

Mental Health

Kirkman reported they purchased two new AC units for spring installation. He asked if he could pursue an earlier bid for security cameras at the mental health center and Piattran. It will not require a bidding process. Winder noted that the air balancing project at the office building was removed from his 2025 budget and replaced with the security camera project at the center and transportation building. So, it is in the budget.
